Excerpt: . . . foregoing remarks were written, in 1833, some changes have been made in the method of surveying the public lands to wit: There are to be no random lines for townships, but all the range lines between them are to be first run north 6 miles, and temporary posts set-- then a true east or west line is to be run through the tract, for the boundary of these townships, and the range lines are curtailed at, or extended to, an intersection with this east or west line. The other ties of townships are surveyed in the same manner. Random lines are now to be run between that section on the west side of the townships, and the courses corrected back from the corners on the range line, instead of making jiew comers as before.
